

FREE SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

The B'ville Express provides free rides for seniors age 60 and up who reside in the towns of Lysander and VanBuren. B'ville Express operates out of Canton Woods Senior Center, transporting seniors to and from medical appointments, local grocery trips, the pharmacy, local banks and to the senior center. The drivers are trusted volunteers from the Baldwinsville community who generously donate their time and the use of their personal vehicles to help our senior friends. The B'ville Express is funded by the **Onondaga County Department of Adult and Long Term Care.**

Once registered with the program, seniors can schedule their transportation needs simply by calling the B'ville Express seven days in advance. Their needs are then coordinated between the B'ville Express and the volunteer drivers. The volunteers go above and beyond by picking up the senior at their home for their scheduled appointment and transporting them safely back home- all at no cost to the senior!

The B'ville Express is also looking for additional volunteer drivers to accommodate the growing need of seniors who lack transportation. There is always a need for volunteer drivers as many seniors are unable to access essential services without the help of the B'ville Express Program.
